From our Pastor

Beloved,

This coming Sunday will begin our Week of Prayer for International Missions and the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. While our goal is \$24,000.00, last year we gave \$27,318.00 to this offering. I would love to see us surpass the \$30,000.00 mark. We can easily do this if we all will give more this year than last year.

As you may know, the value of the dollar is dropping around the world. What this means to our missionaries and our work abroad is that it takes more dollars to make up the difference. Why is the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering so important? The Cooperative Program provides only 36 percent of the International Mission Board's budget.
